At Sharpe Academy, Musical Theatre and Performance is at the core of everything we do. Our parttime classes are tailored to each age group and enable students to build confidence and skills including public speaking and presentation, which will help them in a broad range of career paths.

Sharpe is also a full-time College and can prepare students for a career in Performing Arts, should that be their chosen path. We offer a 3 Year Diploma, 2 Year Accelerated Diploma, and 1 Year Postgraduate courses in Professional Musical Theatre and Acting.

Children in our part-time classes, aged 3 to 18, are taught by some of the same experienced industry professionals as our College students.



Musical Theatre Classes

• Act 1 Musical Theatre is a fun and engaging 45-minute weekly session designed especially for young children. Each class includes a mix of Singing, Dance, Drama, and Public Speaking to help children grow in confidence and creativity.

We also introduce the LAMDA Introductory syllabus, with the option to take exams when your child is ready. Our priority is to create a supportive, group-based environment where children can develop at their own pace – some grow in confidence quickly, while others take a little longer, and that's absolutely fine.

Act 2 and Act 3 Musical Theatre are exciting, weekly 2-hour sessions for children in school years 2 to
7 (ages 6 to 12). They combine Singing, Acting, and Dance – the perfect introduction to Musical Theatre
training. Students work towards full-scale productions, gaining valuable performance experience in a fun
and supportive environment. No previous experience is needed – just an interest in the performing arts and
a willingness to give it a go!

For those keen to develop their acting skills further, we also offer an optional LAMDA Acting Programme (available at an additional cost).

• Our **London Musical Theatre Company** is a weekly 2.5-hour class for students in school years 7–13 (ages 11–18) who are passionate about Musical Theatre and may be considering it as a future career. Students take part in full-scale productions and have the opportunity to audition for principal roles, gaining valuable stage experience and confidence.

While some previous experience in the performing arts or dance is ideal, it's not essential – enthusiasm, commitment, and a love of performing are what matter most.

An optional LAMDA Acting Programme is also available for those who wish to work towards acting grades (additional fees apply).

Additional Dance Classes

We also run a range of optional dance classes for students who wish to add to their Musical Theatre training. These classes include **Ballet**, **Modern**, **Tap** and **Acrobatics**; through these classes, students can take Dance and Acro exams with the ISTD or Acrobatic Arts examining boards.
